Being Sexual: An Illustrated Series on Sexuality and Relationships

Background

Being Sexual: An Illustrated Series on Sexuality and Relationships is a unique 17 booklet series published by SIECCAN in 1993 to meet the educational needs of people with developmental disabilities or problems with language, learning and communication. With over 500 pages of easy-to-understand drawings and text, the *Being Sexual* booklets have been used by learners independently and with the support of parents, teachers, counsellors, and caregivers. Translation of key messages from the text into Blissymbols added another dimension that has led to encouragingly positive reviews and wide distribution of the series. Although *Being Sexual* has been out of print for a number of years, continued requests from professionals exposed to the series at conferences/workshops indicates an ongoing need and demand for this type resource.

The Project

With assistance from the McKesson Foundation and McKesson Canada, SIECCAN has recently republished the series. Our goal is to mobilize new users in classroom settings and in community organizations and agencies, to reconnect with owners of the 550 sets previously distributed, and to gather collaborative feedback from all colleagues who share our commitment to this area of sexual health education. This feedback will facilitate updating of the series, guide possible modification of format to best meet current needs, and help to enhance training in use of the series with different audiences.
