What is HPV?

Human papillomavirus (HPV) is a virus that is spread during sexual contact

HPV can cause **GENITAL WARTS** and **CANCER** in different parts of the body (e.g., throat, cervix, vulva, penis, anus)

What Should I Know?

Without the HPV vaccine, most people will get HPV AT LEAST ONCE in their lifetime

Most of the time, people with HPV

DON'T HAVE

ANY SIGNS

of a HPV infection

If you are or become
SEXUALLY ACTIVE,
you are at risk for
HPV infection



The HPV vaccine

IS VERY SAFE

and can prevent cancers and genital warts

For maximum benefit, get the HPV vaccine

BEFORE you are sexually active

In Canada, the HPV vaccine is available in most

PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

You can also talk to a nurse or doctor about how to obtain the vaccine
